Two Important Financial Aid Applications in California



- depending on student eligibility
- that we are here to support them!



 The FAFSA and the California Dream Act Application are both financial aid applications that do essentially the same thing for two different groups of students

Both applications open the door to many types of important financial aid for college, including state aid, institutional aid, scholarships, loans and more

 It's vital that educators and other student advocates always talk about both applications when they are addressing students and their families

• Please remember that many students and families are reluctant to provide private information. Let them know

- Undocumented Students
- With or without DACA

- Any visa holder (except U)

Why is the California Dream Act **Application (CADAA) Changing?**



The significant redesign to the 2024-2025 FAFSA required changes to the CADAA be made, such as calculating the Student Aid Index (SAI) in place of the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and allowing students to list up to 20 colleges, etc.

This also created an opportunity to make updates and enhancements to the application. For example:



• Streamlining the parent signature process

Embedding the AB 540 affidavit into the application

• Creating a text message 'opt-in' question

Allowing students to indicate interest in the California Dream Act Service Incentive Grant Program (DSIG)

Security Questions



Students will be asked to provide answers to three security questions, which can be used to recover their account if they forget their password.

We recommend that students write down this information (questions and answers) so they can remember it later.



- 2-factor authorization is used each time the account is accessed
- A one-time password will be sent to the student every time they log into their California Dream Act Application
- Students will need to authenticate their account by providing the password they are sent into the space provided

alifornia Dream Act Service Incentive Grant Program allows eligible California Dream Act ant (CADAA) students with a Cal Grant B (or a Cal Grant A with B eligibility) to perform unity or volunteer service. Students will be ed up to \$4,500 per academic year.

ant will be available to students for up to 8 ters or up to 12 quarters while they have an Cal Grant A or B award.
